***NEW YORK TIMES* BEST-SELLING AUTHOR ARCHER MAYOR TO SPEAK AT THE CLIFTON PARK-HALFMOON PUBLIC LIBRARY**

Clifton Park, NY -- Archer Mayor, author of the *New York Times* best-selling, Vermont-based mystery series featuring detective Joe Gunther, will appear at the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library on **Wednesday, August 17 at 7pm**. Mayor will be reading from and autographing his critically-acclaimed 26th novel, *The Company She Kept*. Copies of Mayor's novel will be available for purchase at the event, courtesy of The Open Door Bookstore.

The Company She Kept opens with Joe Gunther and his Vermont Bureau of Investigation called in to investigate an especially brutal crime. The victim is soon identified as not only a state senator, but also as a close confidante of the Governor, and the publicity swirling around the crime starts to impede the VBI's investigation. As his team works to solve the crime, its reverberations are felt across the state.

Archer Mayor has written 26 best-selling Joe Gunther novels. Over the past 30 years, he has worked as a firefighter/EMT, a police officer, and a death investigator for Vermont's Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, as well as a political advance man and a medical illustrator. He is a winner of the Vermont Governor's Award for Excellence in the Arts. *The New York Times* has called Archer Mayor "The boss man on procedures" and *Booklist* says "Mayor's Joe Gunther novels are among the best cop stories being written today."
